Optional War-Time Facts (Document all facts about TIME – PLACE – NAMES – DATES – LOCATIONS - save explanations for time of taped interview)

Compile a chronological listing of all wartime living locations (1939-1945) – list locations and dates. Begin with the start of the war – end with liberation or the end of the war. Be as specific as possible. Stick to facts – tell the stories during the taped interview,

List any incidents where anyone helped you to escape or hide.
List any incidents where you helped anyone else to escape or hide.
List any acts of resistance you witnessed (don't explain – just list)
Did you have any experiences with critical historical events during the war no listed above?

List any physical sears from the war.
Do you have any artifacts from the war? List some examples we can photograph.
